

Do you have an Upcoming FDNY Test? Help avoid violations by following the checklist below.

These are the most common reasons your building will fail if not addressed prior to your **FDNY 5 Year Hydrostatic Test & Residential Flow Test**:

	1	Fire extinguishers are properly mounted, and tags are up to date.
	2	Stairways are clear of all storage.
	3	Stairway doors are self-closing.
	4	Emergency lights are properly working.
-	5	All electrical boxes are properly covered.
	6	Fire safety plan hanging in lobby (residential buildings).
	7	Standpipe fire hose is properly racked or rolled in cabinets.
	8	All exits are clear from obstructions such as boxes or garbage.
	9	All storage is removed from electrical rooms.
	10	All mains, risers, and cross connection piping must be painted red on standpipe & sprinkler systems.
	11	All control valve handles must be painted: green for sprinkler – red for standpipe – yellow for combination.
	12	Items hanging from sprinkler piping (even wires) is prohibited.
	13	All storage must be at least 18 inches below all sprinkler heads.
	14	Proper signage on all valves, FDC's, & doors, Compactor rooms must have a sketch of the system hanging behind a glass frame.
	15	All monthly records are up to date.
- 1 -	16	All control valves are chain and locked or electronically monitored.
	17	All Shrubs and Trees bust be cleared 3' around all FDC's (Fire Department Connections)
	18	If your building has scaffolding in front a red light must be provided in front of all FDC's (Fire Department Connections.

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
